### HUNTER/JUMPER:

What division will this rider show in for the 2017-2018 season? \_\_\_\_\_

A rider's division eligibility will be determined at the beginning of the show season and should remain the same throughout the show year. If a change is necessitated by such circumstances as changing horses due to lameness, etc. mid-season please refer to the IEL rule book HE117 and JP112. A rider may compete in only one (1) Hunter/Jumper division at any given show.

**NOVICE:** Hunter riders will be asked to jump a course of eight fences set at 2'0". There will be no oxers. Riders forfeit eligibility for the Novice division when they have won six (6) or more blue ribbons at any recognized show (USEF, PCHA, LAHJA, SFVHSA) over a course of 2'0" or higher.

**FRESHMAN:** Hunter riders will be asked to jump a course of eight fences set at 2'6". Jumper riders will be asked to jump a course of fences ranging in height from .75m to .80m (2'5" to 2'7") with spreads up to .80m (2'7"). Riders forfeit eligibility for the Freshman division when they have won six (6) or more blue ribbons at any recognized show (USEF, PCHA, LAHJA, SFVHSA) over a course of 3'0" or higher.

**JR. VARSITY:** Hunter riders will be asked to jump a course of eight fences 3'0" in height. Jumper riders will be asked to jump a course of fences ranging in height from .95m to 1.0m (3'1" to 3'3") with spreads up to 1.0m (3'3"). Riders forfeit eligibility for the Junior Varsity division when they have won six (6) or more blue ribbons at any recognized show (USEF, PCHA, LAHJA, SFVHSA) over a course of 3'6" or higher.

**VARSITY:** Hunter riders will be asked to jump a course of fences 3'6" in height. Jumper riders will be asked to jump a course of fences ranging in height from 1.10m to 1.15m (3'7" to 3'9") with spreads up to 1.15m (3'9"). Open to riders that are eligible/able to meet these criteria.

### DRESSAGE:

How long have you been training this rider? \_\_\_\_\_

A rider may compete in only one (1) Dressage division at any given show. The I.E.L offers the following tests.

Training Level: Tests 1, 2 & 3 (Points will count towards Novice school and individual awards.)

First Level: Tests 1, 2 & 3 (Points will count towards Freshman school and individual awards.)

Second Level: Test 1, 2 & 3 (Points will count towards Junior Varsity school and individual awards.)

Third Level: Tests 1, 2 & 3 (Points will count towards Varsity school and individual awards.)

Fourth Level: Tests 1, 2 & 3 (Points will count towards Varsity school and individual awards.)

**NOTE:** The falsification of the Membership and Eligibility Forms may be cause for immediate expulsion of the individual, trainer, school and or team representative from the I.E.L., or any lesser penalty imposed by the I.E.L.'s Board of Directors which may, in the Board's sole discretion, be determined to be appropriate due to any exceptional circumstances brought to the Board's attention.
